JUS SCRIPTUM 2.0 **THE ESSAY COMPETITION**

Shambhunath Institute of Law witnessed a vibrant display of intellectual enthusiasm as it hosted **JUS SCRIPTUM 2025**, the annual **essay-writing competition that encourages students to explore, analyse, and express legal ideas with clarity and conviction.**



The event was thoughtfully organized under the dedicated leadership of **Mrs. Shweta Rai and Ms. Anukriti Pandey**, who ensured a smooth, engaging, and academically enriching experience for all participants. Their efforts created an atmosphere where students felt inspired to delve into contemporary legal issues and showcase their writing abilities.



A total of **56 students** participated in the competition, each given one hour to craft their essays. The topics were designed to suit the academic exposure of different year groups and to spark meaningful critical thought:

LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAM BY LEGAL-AID CLINIC

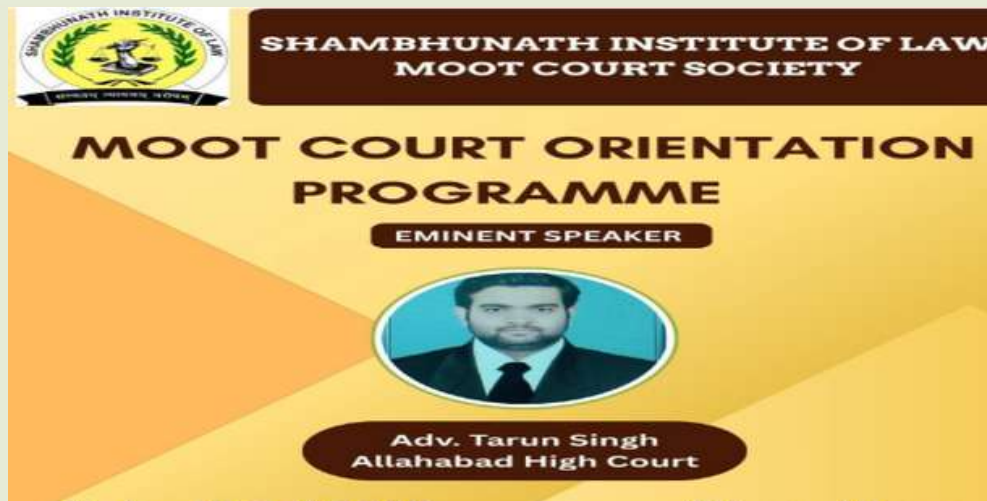


The **Legal Aid Clinic** of Shambhunath Institute of Law continues its commitment to community welfare through legal awareness and empowerment.

The institute takes immense pride in the achievements of its students and extends heartfelt congratulations to all the winners and participants for their commendable performance and dedication.



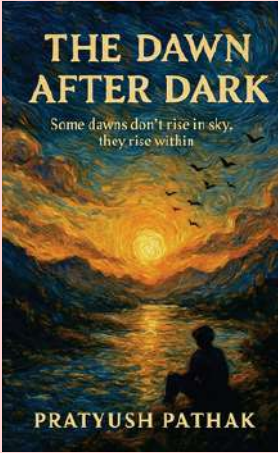
DEEPAWALI CELEBRATION (17TH OCTOBER, 2025)
